## Domestic Abuse and rehousing

#### Request:

We are unable to report on this for non-homeless applications because priority is awarded in multiple ways. Information relation to homeless applications is below.

- Please can you tell me how many victims of domestic abuse have approached the council for help finding new housing in each year over the past five years. See Below
- Please can you tell me what the outcome was for each applicant over the past five years. If you are not able to list the outcome for every applicant, please can you give an overall picture for each year i.e. 20 people were given temporary accommodation etc See Below
- 3. How many of these applicants in each year over the past five years were found not to be in priority need and what reason was given? See Below
- 4. How many of the applicants who were found not to be in priority need successfully appealed the council's decision?

We only manually kept info on reviews, there has never been any formal recording mechanism for this, so we have no data for the first 4 years. From Sept 17 – Feb 2019 we have had no appeals for DV cases on priority needs
