

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BROAD STREET/CHURCH STREET/HIGH STREET BILSTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Wolverhampton City Council have made an Order under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, prohibiting vehicles from proceeding on the following stretches of road:

- Broad Street closed between its junction with Smith Street and Church Street. Pedestrianised zone except for access for deliveries permitted between the hours of 06:00 – 08:30 and 16:00 – 22:00 only.
- Church Street closed between its junction with High Street and Walsall Street. Pedestrianised zone except for access for deliveries permitted between the hours of 06:00 – 08:30 and 16:00 – 22:00 only.
- High Street closed between its junction with Church Street and Dudley Street. Pedestrianised zone except for access for deliveries permitted between the hours of 06:00 – 08:30 and 16:00 – 22:00 only.

The Order may operate for a maximum period of eighteen months', and it is anticipated that the restrictions will operate for eighteen months from 4 July 2020.

The Order is required to facilitate social distancing measures in response to Covid-19.
