Doorstep Scams

If you receive an unexpected visit from a doorstep caller you do not have to answer the door and allow them into your property but if you decide to, it's handy to remember the following:

- Don't feel pressurised into making decisions straight away.
- If you decide to enter into a contract whilst at home you should be provided with a 14 day cancellation period. You should also receive pre-contractual



- information which specifies the name & address of the seller and which describes the goods or services provided, any guarantees and the cost of such.
- Be wary of One Time Only Special Offers or Today Only Discounts which encourage you to sign up for goods or services straight away.
 - Think, Did I want or need this yesterday? If the answer to this is no. Why do you have to have it today?
- Genuine callers won't mind if you ask to check their identity or call back later another day.

City of Wolverhampton Council has not authorised door knocking on its behalf nor does it work in partnership with or promote contractors or check the quality of work completed.

In the unlikely event that you experience aggression or feel threatened or intimidated by a doorstep caller contact the Police on 999.

Top tips to help you and others take a stand

against doorstep scams

1. Never use cold-callers.

2. Consumers are legally entitled to a 14-day cooling off period for contracts formed at their home.

- 3. Check the identity of the caller.
- 4. Encourage people to ask a trusted person for advice on reputable traders.
- Everyone should display a "No Cold Calling" sticker.
- Always report suspicious activity.


Wolverhampton NHS Talking Therapies

Eligibility

To be eligible to use the caravans all of the following must apply:

- The Carer must have had a recent Carers Assessment
- The Carer must be looking after a person with a disability, illness, or mental health need.
- · The person you care for must live in Wolverhampton.

Facilities

The static caravan sleeps up to six people, with an en-suite double bedroom, a twin room and a double pull out bed in the lounge. The accommodation is fully furnished and equipped for your stay. Sheets and pillows are included in the rental fee. The mobile home has a large accessible decked area which is gated and secure for young people to enjoy being safe outside.

- Ramped access fully adapted caravan.
- The hire cost includes electric and gas
- Sleeps up to 6 people
- · Parking available next to the caravan
- Includes 6 entertainment passes.
