Introduction

When to use this form

This regime is known as and referred to as Local Authority Pollution Prevention and Control, LAPPC. Installations permitted under this regime are known as B installations. Use this form if you are sending an application for a 'Part B' permit to City of Wolverhampton Council under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 as amended ("the EP Regulations").
