NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Wolverhampton City Council has made the Wolverhampton City Council (6, 7 and 8 Ellerton Walk, Wolverhampton, WV10 0UG) Compulsory Purchase Order 2024 under the Housing Act 1985 and the Acquisition of Land Act 1981. It is about to submit this Order to the Secretary of State for The Department for Levelling Up, Housing & Communities for confirmation and, if confirmed, the Order will authorise Wolverhampton City Council to purchase compulsorily the land described below for the purpose of the provision of housing accommodation.
