Upon the Court reviewing the operation of a final injunction and power of arrest granted by the Honourable Mr Justice Julian Knowles on 27th February 2024.

And Upon hearing Counsel, Mr Singleton, for the Claimants and none of the Defendants attending nor having indicated any intention to attend.

And Upon the Court accepting that the Defendants have been notified of the review hearing the Claimants having complied with the directions in the order of Her Honour Judge Kelly, dated 8 May 2024.

And Upon the Court considering the written evidence of:

- (1) Pardip Nagra, dated 23 January 2025; and
- (2) PC Mark Campbell, dated 17 January 2025

which detail the beneficial effect of the final injunction and power of arrest and the continuing current risk of street-cruising in the Claimants' local government areas in the absence of such injunction and power of arrest.

And Upon the Claimants having brought to the attention of the Court any matter which the First, Second, Third and Fourth Defendants might wish to raise as potential material changes in legal and/or factual circumstances which could warrant the discharge of the injunction of the power of arrest dated 27 February 2024.

And Upon the Court being satisfied that there have been no such material changes in circumstances.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The final injunction order and power of arrest granted by the Honourable Mr Justice Julian Knowles on 27th February 2024 shall remain in force until 23:59 on 27 February 2027 unless varied or discharged by further Order of the Court.

Review Hearing

- The next review of the operation of the final injunction and power of arrest shall be held on **[please complete with date and time]** at Birmingham District Registry, The Priory Law Courts, 33 Bull Street, Birmingham, B4 6DS. The time estimate is 1 day. The Claimants are to contact the Court no less than 14 days before the hearing date, if the time estimate is significantly different.
- The Claimants shall file with the court a succinct report to inform the court of their experience with the publication, operation and enforcement of the extended order, including for example, breaches, warnings or problems, if any arising out the extended order (including the Power of Arrest) not less than 14 days prior to the review hearing.

Liberty to Apply

Any person served with a copy of, or affected by, the final injunction order may apply to the Court to vary or discharge it, on 48 hours written notice to the Claimant at the address set out at the foot of this Order.

Service on the First to Fourth Defendants

Pursuant to CPR rules 6.15, 6.27 and 81.4(2) (c) and (d), the Claimants shall be permitted to serve this Order on the First to Fourth Defendants by the alternative methods specified at Schedule 1 to this Order.

Service on the Fifth to Fourteenth Defendants

- Pursuant to CPR rules 6.15, 6.27 and 81.4(2) (c) and (d), the Claimants shall be permitted to serve this Order on the Fifth to Fourteenth Defendants using email and/or postal addresses that have been provided to the Claimants in the course of these proceedings.
- The deemed date of service of this Order on the First to Fourth

 Defendants shall be the date of completion of the steps described in

 paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order. The completion of those

 steps is to be verified by a witness statement or certificate of service

 to be filed at Court and uploaded to the Claimant's dedicated

 webpages referred to at para.1 (iii) of Schedule to this Order within 7

days of completing those steps. Service of the said witness statement on the First to Fourth Defendants is dispensed with.

Costs

8 There shall be no order as to costs.
