Public Space Protection Orders

Request:

I am writing to make an open government request for all the information to which I am entitled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

There are four parts to my request.

- At the most recent count, how Gypsies, Travellers and Travelling Showpeople resided in your area of jurisdiction?
 See attached.
- 2) Could I see a copy of any injunctions made by your Council since the 1st of May 2010 under the Local Government Act 1972 or the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 which refer to:
 - i) Gypsies
 - ii) Travellers
 - iii) Showmen/Showpeople
 - iv) Bargees
 - v) Encampments?

The information that you have requested is held on court record, it is exempt from disclosure. Therefore your request for information is being refused on this occasion, under section 32(1) of the Freedom of information Act 2000.

Section 32 - Court records

- (1) Information held by a public authority is exempt information if it is held only by virtue of being contained in—
 - (a) any document filed with, or otherwise placed in the custody of, a court for the purposes of proceedings in a particular cause or matter,
 - (b) any document served upon, or by, a public authority for the purposes of proceedings in a particular cause or matter, or
 - (c) any document created by-
 - (i) a court, or
 - (ii) a member of the administrative staff of a court, for the purposes of proceedings in a particular cause or matter.

LOW HILL

IN PUBLIC AREAS :
"From 20 July 2015 everyone is prohibited from :

- Parking a caravan, or being in a caravan
 Fly-tipping or littering
 Allowing a dog belonging to you or your family to be outside of your control or outside of your home without a lead"

PENALTY FOR BREACH
Fixed Penalty notice £80 (section 68 Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act
OR
Fine up to £1000 (section 67 Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014)
