Information on the split between training that is delivered through face-to-face learning (e.g. classroom-based) and through e-learning for your Adult Social Care staff, separately for the current financial year, for the full 2015/16 financial year and for the full financial year 2011/12.

Information on how you measure the quality of training delivered, the learning achieved and that the learning benefits are sustained within the work place, and any data you have that evidences the quality of training and learning achieved separately for the current financial year, for the full 2015/16 financial year and for the full financial year 2011/12.
