KS2 SATs Boycott

Request:

In May 2010, approximately 26% of primary schools boycotted the KS2 SATs tests due to take place that month. I am conducting analysis regarding regional variation in boycott participation.

For this reason, I am interested in the stance of the council in regard to this issue. I am requesting:

- A copy of any written advice sent from the council (acting in its capacity as a local education authority) to primary school head teachers or board of governors in regards to participation in the boycott To best of our knowledge no written advice was sent to primary school Head teachers or Governing Bodies with regards to national key stage 2 test boycott.
- A copy of any written advice sent to head teachers/governors which discusses the possibility of head teachers being in breach of contract if they participated in the boycott

There is no written advice as per point 1.

- An answer to the following questions:
 - Did the council seek to encourage schools not to participate in the boycott?
 - The Council did not seek to encourage schools not to participate in the boycott.
 - Did the council take no stance on whether schools should participate in the boycott?
 - The council took no stance with regards to the boycott.
 - Did the council inform head teachers that they might be in breach of contract if they participated in the boycott?
 I have no evidence to suggest that any Head Teacher in the City of Wolverhampton was in breach of contract as the result of participating in a test boycott.
