Looked After Children

Request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, I'd be grateful if you would provide the following information in relation to children looked-after by the local authority:-

- 1 How many children are looked-after by the Local Authority? As of 20th January 2017, 641 children
- How many children that are looked-after by the Local Authority have a diagnosis of autism (Autism Spectrum Disorder, Asperger Syndrome)?

 12 of the 641 have a "diagnosis of autism", as measured by the "Autism/Aspergers" Disability classification being on their record. Please note, we cannot distinguish how many are Autism and Asperger separately.
- Has the Designated Health Professional/CCG ever reported to the Corporate Parenting Board on the numbers and needs of looked-after children with an autism diagnosis?
