## Request:

Please could you provide the following information for adults only:

- The number of new "in-county" residential care Learning Disability care placements you have fully or partly funded between 1 July 2016 and 31 December 2016
  - There were 3 new in-county (Wolverhampton) placements that were funded between 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016.
- The number of new "out of county" residential care Learning Disability care placements you have fully or partly funded between 1 July 2016 and 31 December 2016
  - There was 1 new out of county (outside Wolverhampton) placement funded between 1<sup>st</sup> July 2016 and 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016.
