In respect of your above question, it has been established after careful consideration that the Council does not hold the above report information regarding the three named premises above. Consequently, we are unable to provide any information relating to the above, and are informing you as required by Section 1(1) (a) of the Act, that states:

"Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the

description specified in the request".

I can advise you that when the City of Wolverhampton joined the Food Hygiene Rating Scheme a decision was made to rate premises as exempt until they received their next food hygiene intervention. On this intervention they would be given a Food Hygiene Rating Score, which would show up on the Food Standards Agency's Food Hygiene Rating Schemes website.

The rating "exempt" is therefore not as a result of an intervention and there is no report relating to this rating.

We are bringing our premises which are rated "exempt" back into our inspection programme, however the premises inspection regime is based on risk and the premises concerned are generally low risk due to the controls in place at the premises.

One of the premises concerned Tesco – Willenhall Road has recently been re-rated and received a food hygiene rating score of 5.
