People with a Disability in Council Funded Care Settings

Request:

The request relates to all placements, including permanent, long-term and short-term;

By disability we mean all disabilities, including physical disabilities (of which frailty), learning disabilities, autism, mental health conditions and sensory impairments.

The request relates to all adults, i.e. everyone aged 18 years or over.

- How many people with a disability were placed in an accommodation based care setting (i.e. supported living, nursing/care home, NHS facility) in the council area over the course of 2016/17?
 618 this includes all admissions with the exception of a few as most clients have some sort of disability or mental health need.
 - a. Please state the average (arithmetic mean) cost per placement.
 £480 per week.
 Please note that 64 of the clients were placed through block contracts and the cost per placement is not available. These 64 clients have been excluded from the average cost calculation.
 - 2. How many people with a disability who were living at home, were placed 'urgently' in an accommodation based care setting over the course of 2016/17 with a notice period of:
 - a. Between three and six months.
 - b. Between one and 3 months.
 - c. Between one week and one month.
 - d. Less than one week.
