## **Mayoral Election Count**

### Request:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, to request more detailed information relating to the West Midlands mayoral election and the count conducted on 5 May 2017.

Can you please provide counts of votes given to each candidate in the first round and second round, broken down by each polling district or electoral ward in Wolverhampton. I understand that during the count these numbers will have been recorded before being totalled and sent to the Combined Authority Returning Officer.

In respect of your above question, it has been established after careful consideration that the Council does not hold some of the above information in the category you are requesting as a number of wards include postal vote data which is not ward specific. This is because we aggregate all the postal votes for the City and share them out across a number of tables hence where a ward includes postal votes, the results are not a representation of the local vote in that area.

Consequently, we are unable to provide some of the information relating to the above, and are informing you as required by Section 1(1) (a) of the Act, that states:

"Any person making a request for information to a public authority is entitled to be informed in writing by the public authority whether it holds information of the description specified in the request".

However, we can provide you a table (provided on page 3) which shows a breakdown of ward results from last week's Mayoral election which include postal vote data – which is not ward specific which we hope you will find useful.

With reference to your above questions, please find information provided on page three.
