Schools and Children's Services

Request:

I wish to make a number of requests for information, under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act.

- (a) How many providers of childcare and early years education will be operating in your local authority area in academic year 2017-18? PVI's 68 Sch Nursery/Primary 68
 - (b) How many providers of childcare and early years education were operating in your local authority area in academic year 2015-16? PVI's 63 Sch Nursery/Primary 68
 - (c) How many childcare and early years providers in your local authority area have said that they will <u>not</u> participate in the Government's scheme to offer 30 hours free childcare per week from September 2017?

 15 have declined to offer 30 hours to date.
- 2. How many looked after and previously looked after children living in your local authority area, who applied for a primary or secondary school place starting in September 2017, were not offered a place at a school within your local authority area? 0
- 3. How many teachers at local authority maintained schools in your area have had to take a leave of absence due to stress in the following academic years:
 - (a) 2014-15
 - (b) 2015-16
 - (c) 2016-17

- parenting programmes, tower hamlets council
- parenting skills training, Hammersmith and Fulham
- Parent Support Unit, Enfield.

As well as funding allocated to run children's centres.

*These figures are for Children's Centres/Localities - There is not a specific budget for parenting support programmes, parental engagement is incorporated as part of the overall Early Years Strategy.
