Frameworks and Tenders

Request:

Many council owned and managed properties have pumping stations or off-mainsgrid sewage treatment plants. Councils and Local Authorities typically manage these to functional and manufacturer guidelines, which includes periodic servicing, maintenance, tankering, inspection, new installation, health and safety upgrades, and sourcing of spare parts (the "Relevant Services").

1/ Jurisdiction

- A. Schools and Colleges.
