#### **Election Count Data**

#### Request:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, to request information that you may hold relating to recent election counts.

These relate to the following elections held in your authority:

- West Midlands police and crime commissioner election, on 15 November 2012
- West Midlands police and crime commissioner by-election, on 21 August 2014
- West Midlands police and crime commissioner election, on 6 May 2016
- General election, on 6 May 2010
- General election, on 7 May 2015
- General election, on 8 June 2017

Can you please provide counts of votes given to each candidate, broken down by polling district, electoral ward, or any other geographical unit used on the night of each election count. I understand these figures will have been recorded and communicated to the relevant Returning Officer in order to establish the final declared result. This data may be stored in the form of a spreadsheet used on the night.

Where relevant can you also share the same data for the second round of voting as well as turnout figures from verification.

I don't mind what format you use, but would appreciate the data in a CSV or spreadsheet format rather than PDF.
