## **Smoking Cessation Services**

### Request:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following information from the local authority regarding the commissioning of smoking cessation services in your area:

Please provide the information asked for in the following questions:

- If a smoking cessation service were to be commissioned in your area would it be your responsibility. If not, whose? Public Health are the commissioners of smoking cessation services in Wolverhampton.
- Do you currently commission smoking cessation services from community pharmacies in your area? We currently have a community contract for smoking cessation which include pharmacy providers.

### If yes:

- How many individual community pharmacies do you commission a smoking cessation service from in your area? We currently have 30 pharmacies commissioned to provide smoking cessation across Wolverhampton
- What is the annual value of the commissioning contracts with community pharmacies in your area? 2015/16 & 2016/17. see below
- What was the value of the contracts with community pharmacies in your area in 2013/14 & 2014/15? see below

The community contract is for smoking cessation. Not all pharmacies are commissioned to provide smoking cessation. We currently have 40 pharmacy providers.

The contract that smoking cessation in pharmacies comes under is the community services contracts that includes GP and other health care providers (including Health Exchange), and is not solely for pharmacies.
