### Below are the responses relating to food poisoning in 2017:

'Complaints About Food Poisoning'

Please be advised that:

- these figures relate to allegations of food poisoning and not confirmed cases. City of Wolverhampton Council has not established any cause of poisoning from any of these premises.
- often individuals believe that their symptoms relate to food eaten at the last establishment they visited. This is not always the case and may be from food eaten at home or in a different establishment. Usually with symptoms of food poisoning it takes time for the bacteria that causes illness to enter the gut and grow (usually it would be something eaten at least 12-36 hours before if not longer).
- there are also viral conditions that present similar symptoms to that of food poisoning organisms, such as rotavirus or norovirus, which are passed from person to person very easily.
- to confirm whether symptoms are as a result of food poisoning individuals are advised to visit their GPs as soon as possible. A stool sample will be used to determine the specific food poisoning organism causing the symptoms (if applicable).

#### 'US-owned'

We have assumed that you mean 'US-branded' fast food chains rather than US-owned.

Whilst the brand names originate from the US, the majority of franchises carrying these brand names are owned by independent franchisees (often British) rather than the brand company itself.
