Re-use of Public Section Information Regulations

Request:

Pursuant to the Re-use of Public Sector Information Regulations, we are seeking the right to re-use all documents and information publicly available through your website for the West Midlands Pension Fund. We seek the ability to re-use the documents and information in the following manner: include the information in our searchable commercial database and make the responsive documents available to our clients for reference and/or download.

In reference to your recent request, the Re-use of Public Sector Information Regulations 2005 established a framework for making the re-use of public sector information easier and more transparent. The main aims of the Regulations are:

- Fairness
- Transparency
- Timing
- Openness
- Consistency

Re-use means the use by a person (or company) of a document held by the Council for a purpose other than the initial purpose for which the document was produced.

The Re-use of Public Sector Information Regulations does not provide access to the information itself. That is available through the Freedom of Information Act 2000, Data Protection Act 1998 or other access to information regimes such as the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

Receiving information under the Freedom of Information Act and other information access regimes does not give you an automatic right to re-use the information. You must make a distinct request to re-use it. In this case you asked for Re-use of Public Sector Information of all documents and information publicly available through your website for the West Midlands Pension Fund.
