Child Adoption

Request:

I would like to know if Wolverhampton has any targets set for child adoption and if so what are they, and who is responsible?

City of Wolverhampton Council does not set targets for child adoption.

In addition I would like to know if there are any bonuses or other incentives for social workers or other staff for the progress of, or completion of adoptions.

There are no incentives or bonuses.

Could you please let me know over the last two years how many babies have been removed from their mothers in the Wolverhampton area by the local authority. In 2017, the local authority removed (by an order of the Court) 31 babies aged 12 months and under.

In 2018 to date, the local authority removed (by an order of the Court) 13 babies aged 12 months and under.
