Request:

I would like to know in each of the last three years - 2015/16, 2016/17, 2017/18 - how much the council made from parking charges, both on-street and car parks. In answer to your above question, please note that the figures provided reflect gross income and therefore do not include any offsetting costs associated with the provision of the Parking service and any use in accordance with statutory guidance.

It is important to note that the figures for 2016-2017 reflect the six-month closure of the Civic Centre car park for refurbishment and the temporary closure of the nearby Civic Halls entertainment venue as part of its £38.0 million refurbishment. All of this supports the ongoing regeneration of the city centre with some one billion of investment on site as planned.
