Request:

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act of 2000, to request the following information:

- 1) Over the last five years, how much of the Wolverhampton City Council's budget was spent on analysis or monitoring for hazardous chemicals in consumer products?

In respect of question 1, it has been established after careful consideration that the Council does not hold the above information as we do not analyse our spend in the format requested.

Consequently, we are unable to provide any information relating to the above, and are informing you as required by Section 1(1) (a) of the Act, that states:
