- Does the council use any garden/environmental products that contain glyphosate? If so, what are they?
 Schools Use: Yes, (Round Up Pro Now Trustee 450 Amenity) Northycote Farm Use: Yes, Clinic Ace – Aqueus Concentrate Environmental Services: Yes, Round Up Pro
- Does the council use Roundup or RangerPro weed killer from company Monsanto? If so, which products? Schools Use: Yes in 2014/2015 Northycote Farm Use: No Environmental Services: Round Up Pro Wolverhampton Homes Use: Continental Landscapes use Roundup weed killer. The product used is Round UP Pro Biactive.
- How much has the council spent on these items in five years? (Separated by each year and product) Schools:
 - 14/15 Round Up Pro = £4,004
 - 15/16 Amenity 450 = £200
 - 16/17 Amenity 450 = £354
 - 17/18 Amenity 450 = £472
 - 18/19 Amenity 450 to date = £348
