In Wolverhampton in 2017, 25 people died by suicide. Breakdowns by age, sex and ethnicity are not available as small numbers within categories would make individuals potentially identifiable – however, further information on trends and risk factors are available via Public Health England's Suicide Prevention Profiles: http://fingertipsreports.phe.org.uk/suicide/e08000031.pdf

Data are currently only available until 2017. The time lag is due to the time taken for inquests to be completed.
