Please note that with reference to inspection activity, the service is aiming to be intelligence led and so it does not act on every report or incident it receives. Information is considered, patterns of trading are looked at and enforcement action is conducted. As some indicative examples we have over the period:

- * Seized over 750000 illicit cigarettes
- * Seized 15 unsafe electrical goods
- Suspended 400 pieces of unsafe baby furniture
- * Had a successful Proceeds of Crime Application
- * Conducted 4 premises licence reviews which have led to revocations
- * Secured 4 rogue traders imprisoned
- * Taken part in Operation Jasper-a national online counterfeiting operation
- * Assisted vulnerable traders in c20 successful small claims court hearings

Additionally we do not carry out routine(or programmed inspections). We try and devise surveys/trade audits/ exercises in an attempt to respond to identified patterns of complaints or issues.
