Request:

How much money has been spent by your council on domestic violence refuge services in each of the last five financial years

a. 2013-14

In respect of question 1 for the year 2013-2014, it has been established after careful consideration that the Council does not hold the above information.

How many individual domestic violence refuge spaces are there currently in your local authority area?

50 spaces in total commissioned by the Local Authority. The Haven also have additional spaces funded that are not commissioned by the Local Authority.

How many domestic violence refuge spaces in your local authority area are currently accessible to people with physical disabilities?

The number of spaces accessible to women with physical disabilities is 6 at any one time.
