## **Election Matters**

## **Request:**

Please can you provide the following information from the most recent scheduled (IE not by-elections) local elections held in your council area and from the General Election in 2017.

 The number of Polling Stations / Polling Places in your council area? Local Election – 129 polling stations / 106 polling places. General Election – 139 polling stations / 105 polling places (difference due to double stations sharing same polling place)

The increased number of polling stations for a general election is because one of the Wolverhampton constituencies includes a ward from neighbouring Dudley.

- The number of Polling Station Inspectors appointed and their standard fee? LE - 13 PSI's, £240 fee. GE - 20 PSI's, £240 fee
- The number of Presiding Officers appointed and their standard fee? LE – 129 presiding officers, £216 fee. GE – 139 presiding officers- £211 fee
- The number of Poll Clerks appointed and their standard fee? LE – 218 poll clerks, £140 fee. GE – 237 poll clerks, £135 fee
- The number of Counting Assistants appointed and their standard fee? LE – 170 count assistants, £11.51 hourly fee - totalled £57.55. GE – 216 count assistants, £11.51 hourly fee - totalled £57.55
- The number of Senior Counting Assistants/Count Supervisors/Team Leader appointed and their standard fee? LE - 20 count supervisors, £17.93 hourly fee - totalled £107.58, 20 assistant count supervisors £14.24 per hour - totalled £85.38. GE - 21 count supervisors, £17.93 per hour - totalled £125.51, 42 assistant count supervisors - £14.24 per hour, totalled £99.61

- 7. The number of Deputy Returning Officers appointed and their standard fee? LE - 3 DRO's, £500 fee. GE - 4 DARO, £500 fee
- 8. The number of Postal Vote Opening Clerks (or similar) and their standard fee? LE - 27 -  $\pounds$ 8.75 per hour. GE - 22 -  $\pounds$ 8.75 per hour
- The number of Postal Vote Opening Supervisors and their standard fee? LE – 11. GE – 15. Various roles for both - Team leader - £11.51 per hour, Supervisor £17.93 per hour, Adjudicator - £14.23 per hour, co-ordinator – £22.38 per hour.
- 10. If the previous elections this information has been supplied for were single or multiple elections (EG combined with a parish election or election of a Mayor) and if it was a multiple election how many of the Polling Stations/Places did this apply to if not all in your council area? This information is related to standalone elections
- In addition to any standard fee for the items 2-9 any additional fixed fees for training, travel or other items?
  For both LE and GE Training fee for all Polling station inspectors, presiding officers, poll clerks, count supervisors and assistant count supervisors £30.

We also pay a flat rate  $\pounds$ 5 travel and subsistence fee to poll clerks and  $\pounds$ 10 to Presiding Officers. Some Presiding Officers also received  $\pounds$ 15 if they have to collect polling booths.
