Unaccompanied Asylum Seeking Children Numbers, budget and accommodation

Request and response in 'blue':

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. In order to assist you with this request, I am outlining my query as specifically as possible:

- How many unaccompanied asylum seeking children is the local authority currently responsible for? (as at 1 September 2015, or nearest marker) 3 as of 21st September 2015.
- How many former relevant children (i.e. former unaccompanied asylum seeking children between the ages of 18-21 years) is the local authority responsible for?
 9 as of 21st September 2015.
- How many appeal rights exhausted post-18 unaccompanied asylum seeking children is the local authority currently responsible for? (as at 1 September 2015, or nearest marker)
 We do not hold this information.
- 4. a. How many UASCs can the LA accommodate?
 - how many foster beds are theoretically available?
 - how many places in supported accommodation are theoretically available?
 - b. What percentage of each are currently being used? We don't specifically have placements for UASC given the small numbers, however, when we needed to find a placement we would seek to find one that meet their individual needs.
- 5. What is the Local Authority's overall spend budgeted for looking after UASC (including Care leavers) in 2015/16. How much is expected to be reimbursed by Home Office?

Yes the amount has reduced, £270,465 was received in 2010/11 based on last year's grant we would expected to receive in the region of £50,000. Due to monthly claims submitted to the home office it is difficult to project the exact amount of income that will be received at this stage of the financial year.
